4. CHIEF EXECUTIVES REPORT:

Joe Cunningham, Chief Executive presented a report to members as follows;

Further Education and Training Services

Transfer of Training Services

Phase three of the transfer of training services to ETBs has commenced and a number of meetings of the Implementation Group has taken place. An Expression Of Interest has been circulated to the staff at Longford and Westmeath ETB responsible for the management of training services in Laois and Offaly.

Youth Services

Youthreach

Consultations have taken place collectively with all staff teams and with students in two centres as part of a planning process for two new initiatives that respond to the challenges facing Youthreach nationally — a pre-Youthreach programme for those not yet ready to participate at QQI Level 4 and a post-Youthreach programme focused on self-directed learning and enabling students to be better prepared for progression options.

Traineeship

The national pilot Hospitality Traineeship is nearing the end of the planning phase. Hotels in Laois and Offaly are partnering with LOETB to design and implement a training programme that integrates work placement and on-site training at hotels with certified training provided by the ETB. It is a labour-market initiative that forms part of LOETB's Youth Guarantee.

Administrative Services

HR

There will be some further teaching staff recruitment in August when we receive our Final Staff Allocation for 2015/2016. We are currently recruiting for a Substitute Panel for Second Level Schools for the academic year 2015/2016.

Recruitment for a Co-ordinator of our VTOS programme at Tullamore FEC has taken place; interviews were held last Friday (24 July) and candidates will be notified presently.

We are currently commencing recruitment for our Further Education Service including a Substitute Panel for 2015/2016.

Recruitment in respect of Special Needs Assistants will take place in the coming week.

Capital

The work at Tullamore College is progressing well and has advanced to the first floor. Mechanical and Electrical works have also commenced.

Tenders have been completed and the Department of Education and Skills have approved the funding for the additional accommodation at Oaklands Community College. Tenders have also been completed for the supply of loose furniture for Oaklands Community College.

Roof works at St. Fergal's College are ongoing and should completed before school reopens.

Portlaoise College has made an application for funding renovations of two classrooms in respect of an Agricultural Science Laboratory.

Procurement

Service agreements have been finalised with The School Food Company to provide canteen services at Ard Scoil Chiaráin Naofa, Clara, St Fergal's College Rathdowney and Coláiste Naomh Cormac, Kilcormac.

Tenders have been sought for the Bus Service at Abbeyleix Further Education Centre.

Tenders have also been sought for Catering at Portarlington FEC and Portlaoise College.

NIS Ltd. was the successful tenderer for the provision of IT support and network maintenance.

Eircom was the successful tenderer for the provision of mobile devices.

Finance

The credit committee of AIB have approved our application for an overdraft facility.

Corporate Services

A series of meetings are currently underway with Trustees of our Community Schools to ensure the necessary supports and structures are in place.

Information Technology

An upgrade of the IT facilities at Clara Youthreach has commenced; this will facilitate delivery of an IT-focused course in association with FIT (Fast-track to IT).
